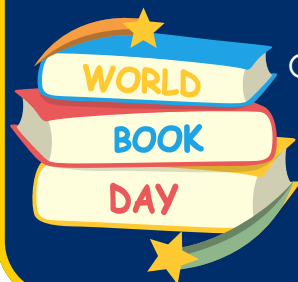

Costumes do not need to be elaborate or newly purchased - families are encouraged to get creative and use items they already have at home!

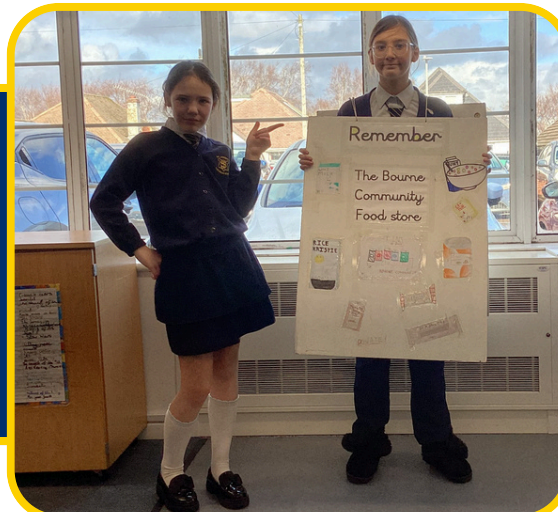
