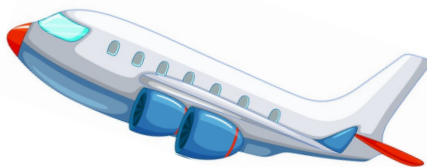


Little Notices:

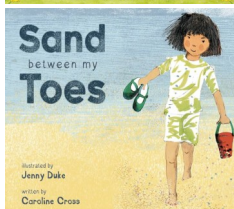
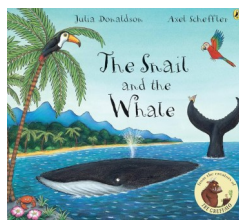
Our Wonderful World (6 weeks)
